PASTOR'S CORNER

1 Corinthians 13 The Excellence of Love

If I speak with the tongues of men and of angels but have not love [for others growing out of God's love for me], then I have become only a noisy gong or a clanging cymbal [just an annoying distraction]. And if I have the gift of prophecy [and speak a new message from God to the people], and understand all mysteries, and [possess] all knowledge; and if I have all [sufficient] faith so that I can remove mountains, but do not have love [reaching out to others], I am nothing

Love is the foundation of our trust and hope in God and our interactions with one another. This verse in Corinthians is often used for weddings but it means so much more in everyday life. Especially, as a Pastor that I speak in love, and not speak as a noisy cymbal. As a Pastor, that I do not just share knowledge but speak a message from God to his people. As a Pastor, that I do not hold my faith for myself but to reach out in action to all people. We are all conduits of God's love reaching into the world with love, sharing God's hope, light, joy and peace...with LOVE.

And Love is what I feel for all of you at North Valley. So I am hurting and saddened to share that I gave my notice to the Council to end my call as of January 30, 2022. Hopefully, right after you have your Annual Meeting and have some clarity as to your future.

God called me into ministry and into each church I have served...hopefully, I have listened and followed whatever God wanted to make known. As you all know, God is not real clear on exactly what we are to do when given a call...just do it!

That is the test of Faith, to follow wherever God leads. And then we are to have some sense of peace in that process...like trusting that God has your back or that God has filled you with the right words, thoughts, and directions.

Isn't that what the shepherds did that night so long ago? Stopped what they were doing, caring for the sheep and take off for the city to see what was causing the star and the angels excitement. It wasn't one shepherd but all of them that saw this site, followed, and realized the extraordinary brilliance of the Babe in the Manger, Jesus.

Something marvelous! Isn't that what we feel each Christmas Eve when family, friends gather and we remember jointly the meaning of Christmas, the love of God, came down incarnate in Jesus Christ. A love so great, it changes us forever, to be that love in the world where we share the message of God's love and peace and living it out each and every day.

May each of you feel that love inside, know the Lord loves you, will always be there for You; won't let you go. God came down...for YOU! Let that Love shine in all that you do. Christmas Blessings,


