

"From Worry to Wonder"

Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

From Jesus's "Sermon on the Mount" Matthew 6:34 New Revised Standard Version Updated Edition ³⁴ "So do not w<u>orry</u> about tomorrow, for tomorrow will bring <u>worries</u> of its own. Today's trouble is enough for today.

This text is the basis for "From Worry to Wonder" the Synod Ministry theme for this year.

As we are in the last weeks of the Season of Pentecost "Green and Growing" and process for Calling a new Pastor for our Parish. Brother Paul reminds us in his letters to the Church that "God is Calling"

As we are on this journey as Congregations and a Parish to Call a new Pastor, we each need to listen to the Lord as to what are our Gifts of the Spirit and the Fruits of the Spirit in the Life of our Congregations and Parish. The following scriptures remind us of those.

Spiritual Gifts - 1 Corinthians 12:4-11 NRSV

⁴ Now there are varieties of gifts, but the same Spirit; 5 and there are varieties of services, but the same Lord; 6 and there are varieties of activities, but it is the same God who activates all of them in everyone. ⁷ To each is given the manifestation of the Spirit for the common good. ⁸ To one is given through the Spirit the utterance of wisdom, and to another the utterance of knowledge according to the same Spirit, ⁹ to another faith by the same Spirit, to another gifts of healing by the one Spirit, ¹⁰ to another the working of miracles, to another prophecy, to another the discernment of spirits, to another various kinds of tongues, to another the interpretation of tongues. 11 All these are activated by one and the same Spirit, who allots to each one individually just as the Spirit chooses.

The Fruit of the Spirit - Galatians 5:22-26 NRSV

²² By contrast, the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, generosity, faithfulness, ²³ gentleness, and self-control. There is no law against such things. ²⁴ And those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires. ²⁵ If we live by the Spirit, let us also be quided by the Spirit. ²⁶ Let us not become conceited, competing against one another, envying one another.

We need to ask ourselves; What am I being CALLED to DO as part of this Journey and beyond? As Paul states in 1 Corinthians chapter 12 we are ALL to work together in telling the World about God's Love towards ALL people through his son Jesus not just the pastor. As God calls us "From Worry to Wonder".

We are doing well financially, meeting payroll and other expenses. As we are getting close to the \$125,000.00 goal to have in reserve for the Pastor's salary package when we do have a Pastor to Call. Your Congregation Councils and the Parish Council are looking at what are our options once we have reached that goal until we Call a Pastor.
